

Skyworld Aviation ends 2011 with another sale to SprintAir

Skyworld Aviation is pleased to announce their latest deal with SprintAir SA of Poland, a Saab 340A QC aircraft, serial number 070, which was delivered on 22nd December 2011.

This latest transaction takes SprintAir's fleet to thirteen Saab 340s which makes the airline the second largest operator of the type in Europe. In a deal arranged by Skyworld Aviation, SE-KCT, was purchased from Sverigeflyg Leasing of Sweden. It is a Quick Change aircraft, capable of carrying 34 passengers or operating in full cargo configuration enabling the aircraft to be flown on passenger and cargo routes with Sprint Air's existing client base which include Polish Post and LOT. Skyworld Aviation has worked with the airline since 2005 when they acquired their first two Saab 340A QC aircraft. Since then SprintAir has undergone a rapid fleet expansion and Skyworld Aviation has been involved with supplying 6 aircraft out of their current fleet of 13 Saabs.

SprintAir markets themselves as primarily a cargo operator but has recently been able to offer increased passenger services with a dedicated passenger aircraft as well as their existing QC aircraft. Their mission is "to provide highly customized transport solutions which meet customers' needs for top level reliability of operations and the highest standard of product". Skyworld Aviation is proud to be associated with the airline and looks forward to working with SprintAir again on future aircraft acquisitions.
